Discussion

Say: You as teens are bombarded with the message that premarital sex is acceptable. Sexual immorality is even downplayed in some Christian circles as no more harmful as gossip or greed.

Ask: Where do you think you stand w/ your friends?
a) more conservative b) less conservative c) about the same

- ➔ Why do you think some well-intentioned Christian teens fall into sexual sins so easily?
- ➔ Are there double standards in the attitudes between males and females toward purity?

Key Passage: (Song of Sol. 2:15) Read and discuss.
“Catch us the foxes, the little foxes that spoil the vines, for our vines have tender grapes.”

Discuss: What could this passage be saying about a relationship before marriage? How about the passage in (8:4) “Daughters of Jerusalem, I charge you: **Do not arouse or awaken love until it so desires.**”

- ➔ What could Solomon be talking about there?
- ➔ How much do you think boundaries are necessary when you are dating?

Key Step: Encourage students to seek out godly adults who are willing to talk about issues related sexuality. Be willing to share and be open and honest.
