



RETHINK – “Recover” When Crisis Hits

Discussion

Key passage: (Heb. 4:14-16) Have someone read it.

*“14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may **obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.**”*

Ask:

- What two things can you expect from God in times of need? (look in v.16)
- Has tragedy ever caused you to doubt God or your faith?

Read: “God may not always give you what you want, but He will give you what you need.” You have a Savior that understands. Your parents may not, your teachers or pastors may not, your friends won't totally, but Jesus does.

Discuss: Why does God give us grace to get through our circumstances, and not from them? What are God's promises versus your expectations?

Pray: Have your group break up into smaller groups.
